USB Creation Windows 10

In this tutorial, we will show you how to create a bootable USB with Windows 10 (64bit). In order to do it you will need:

- Microsoft Media Creation Tool for Windows 10
- A USB flash drive that is at least 8GB and no bigger than 64GB

IMPORTANT NOTE

Make sure to backup all valuable data that is on a flash drive. Everything will be wiped out during USB creation.
